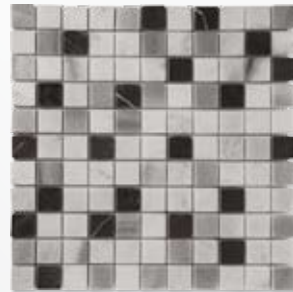

# technical information

## Limestone

Limestone is a sedimentary rock formed over millions of years from deposits of marine invertebrates. It is predominantly white with numerous fascinating fossilised remains. These stone items are all natural and are susceptible to pits, cracks and heavy veining effects. They can also have extreme colour differences, even in the same box. These are natural characteristics of stone. These are not flaws but the natural beauty of stone as no two pieces are alike. Please ensure you inspect all of the material prior to fixing. Check thickness, sizing, colour and veining. Mix all the stones to achieve an acceptable blend.

## Travertine

Travertine is a form of Limestone which is harder and varies in colour from light ivory to a dark noce. Raw travertine has a honeycomb structure which is pitted with holes. In cool Limestone regions calcite-rich water seeps down through rocks to fill cavities with stalactites and stalagmites. Here it is formed by tiny particles that are carried up through watery sprays, to become almost a river 'frozen in time'. Travertine is the deposit left behind. Travertine can develop small holes which is quite normal due to the nature of this stone. Here are some of the many ways to prepare Travertine Stone:

### Honed & Filled:

This is where the stone has been filled with resin, the stone is then smoothed off leaving no holes or pits.

### Unfilled:

Raw travertine features pits and holes. You can use a resin filler or grout to fill any voids that appear.

This stone is of a honeycombed structure which needs attention from time to time in filling the small holes.

The tiles are not sub-standard but this will happen with Travertine honed & filled. The area must be sealed again to strengthen the area.

### Tumbled Travertine:

These tiles have been put in a large hopper full of small stones.

This process smoothes out the edges and gives an aged look.

### Marble:

Is actually Limestone that has been crystallised and can be polished to bring out the natural colour.

### Chipped Edge Travertine:

The edges are chipped away by chains leaving an aged look.

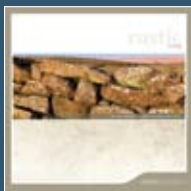
